

ACKNOWLEDGING that:

 Raja Peary Mohan College is a heritage college in Hooghly District of West Bengal, India [NAAC accredited with B grade (2.70); ISO 9001:2015] under the University of Calcutta established in 1887 by Joykrishna Mukherjee. It offers undergraduate, level Course in various Arts, Commerce and Science subjects.

2. The Indian National Trust for Art and Cultural Heritage (INTACH), founded in 1984 is recognised as one of the world's largest heritage organizations with 190 chapters across India, the Headquarter being located at 71, Lodi Estate, New Delhi 110.003. The Hooghly chapter established in 2020 spearheads heritage awareness and conservation in Hooghly district of West Bengal which boasts of major tangible and intangible heritage wealth.

DESIRING to support the cooperation between the Parties in education and training programs: **PURSUANT** to the prevailing laws and regulations, policies, and procedures of India **HAVE REACHED** the following understanding:

ARTICLE 1: OBJECTIVE OF COOPERATION

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to cooperate in educational projects in areas of mutual interest.

ARTICLE 2: SCOPE OF COOPERATION

The Parties agree to implement cooperation programs including but not limited to:

- 1. Exchange on best practices
- Institute a Lecture series on Heritage Awareness; shared co-operation on selection of eminent speakers for Lecture series
 - student Competitions across institutions of the district to instil heritage consciousness about conservation
- 409 Mills based short-term certification courses/programmes on heritage awareness that are left to the choice of the two parties
- 5. Vont application for State/National/International Projects based on Heritage Awareness
- Creation of written resources like brochures/books/maps that will enhance heritage awareness in the district
- 7. Creation of audio-visual content related to heritage of the district
- 8. Organisation of heritage-based public exhibitions
- 9. Other areas as mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

ARTICLE 3: LOCATION OF ACTIVITIES

 The Parties agree to implement the programs stated in Article HOOGHLY.

2. Any changes of the location of the programs shall be mutually agreed

ARTICLE 4: EXECUTING AGENCY

To implement this MOU:

- 1. RPMC appoints the Principal, herein after referred to as RPMC rep.
- INTACH HOOGHLY appoints the Convenor, hereinafter referred to as INTACH HOOGHLY rep.

ARTICLE 5: FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENT

- 1. Any cooperation under this MOU is subject to the availability of funding sources and approval by relevant authorities
- Any specific project of joint interest will be detailed in a separate agreement, including financial and program specific arrangements.

ARTICLE 6: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Each Pacty shall protect, within its territory, intellectual property rights of the other party in accordance with the domestic law in force in their respective countries.

2. In case of specific arrangement, programs or projects that may result in intellectual troperty, the Parties shall conclude separate arrangement in accordance with their respective laws and regulations.

ARTICLE 7: CONFIDENTIALITY

In the event that either Party wishes to disclose any data and/or information supplied in or resulted from the implementation of this MOU, the disclosing Party shall have prior written consent from the other Party.

ARTICLE 8: LIMITATION OF PERSONNEL ACTIVITIES

The Parties shall ensure that their personnel engaged in the activities under this MOU shall engage only in activities under the framework of this MOU with respect to national laws and regulations of the respective countries.

ARTICLE 9: SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

Any dispute concerning the interpretation and/or application of this MOU shall be settled amicably through consultation or negotiation between the Parties.

ARTICLE 10: AMENDMENT

- 1. This MOU may be amended or revised at any time by mutual written consent of The Parties, and such amendment shall form an integral part of this MOU.
- 2. Such amendment or revision shall come into force on the date as may be determined by the Parties.

ARTICLE 11: ENTRY INTO FORCE, DURATION AND TERMINATION

MOU shall enter into force on the date of signing.




Heritage Quiz 2022 in Progress
