

Objective of this course :

A course on Detective Fiction can serve as a valuable tool in preparing individuals for the literary Evolution of Detective fictions and how the popularity of this genre effected a stream of writers to went on this way and how “Shajarur kanta” or “The Quills of Porcupine” is a exception which captivates readers and critics.

The Objectives of a Detective Fiction Course have the common objectives that includes :

- 1. Familiarizing students with the history and development of the Detective Fiction Genre :** This objective involves introducing students to key authors , works and movements within the genre. Students will study the evolution of Detective Fiction from its early origins to contemporary examples.
- 2. Analyzing the Elements and techniques of Detective Fiction :** This objective focuses on helping students understand the various components that make up a detective fiction story, such as plot structure, character development, setting and narrative style. Students will learn how these elements contribute to the overall effectiveness of a Detective story.
- 3. Developing Critical thinking and Analytical Skills :** Detective Fiction often requires readers to engage in deductive reasoning and problem solving. In a detective fiction Course, students are encouraged to analyze clues, make predictions and evaluate evidence in order to solve mysteries alongside the protagonist. This objective aims to enhance students’ ability to think critically and analytically.
- 4. Exploring themes of Social issues in Detective Fiction :** Detective Fiction often addresses broader societal concerns and can be a vehicle for social

commentary. This objective involves examining these themes are portrayed and how they relate to the real-world issues.

- 5. Enhancing Literary analysis and interpretation skills:** Through close reading and textual analysis, students can develop their skills in interpreting and analyzing literary texts. They may study the use of Symbolism, foreshadowing, irony and other literary devices employed in Detective Fiction. This objective aims to deepen students' understanding of literary techniques and enhance their ability to analyze and interpret texts.
- 6. Cultivating an appreciation for Detective Fiction as a form of literature:** This objective involves fostering an appreciation for the genre as a unique and valuable form of literature. Students may explore the reasons why detective fiction has remained popular over time and analyze its cultural significance. They may also discuss the impact of Detective Fiction on other genres and media.

These objectives aim to provide students with a comprehensive understanding of a Detective Fiction as a genre, develop their critical thinking and analytical skills and encourage them to engage with the themes and social issues explored within Detective Fiction stories.

“Shajarur Kanta” or “The Quills of the Porcupine”, which was one of the last Byomkesh stories to be published. This novella is a classic example of how Bandyopadhyay became more ambitious in his later work, eschewing the traditional narrative format and turning his gaze to a larger canvas. In fact, Byomkesh makes his entry quite late into the story, and only after we as readers already know nearly all the facts of the case.

“Shajarur Kanta” centres on a seemingly random series of murders, each perpetuated with a porcupine quill, each victim belonging to a different class of society. As the plot unfolds, we realise that the murders are in some way connected to the lives of an unhappily married couple and a group of disparate characters who meet each evening for social chit-chat. Intercut with the murder mystery are observations on class and caste differences, the alienation inherent in big-city living, and the dual natures of people – though of course these musings don’t preclude an exciting denouement featuring a bulletproof vest and Byomkesh using his “iron fist” to knock out a criminal.

In the most ambitious passage of the story, the omniscient narrator follows the nighttime lives of each of the principal characters, using their activities to comment on the dark underbelly of even the most conventional social orders. One gets a sense here of a society in transition, of the restlessness and disaffection of people who live in a big city, and how easily crime can breed in such a setting (at times, it’s easy to forget that the period is the 1950s). Bandyopadhyay seems to be making a self-conscious attempt to transcend the trappings of his genre – though the narrative structure feels a little forced at times, it’s an undeniably intriguing approach to what might otherwise have been by-the-numbers mystery.
